Special Weather Bulletin

Yesterday's Cyclonic Storm 'TITLI' over West-central Bay of Bengal further intensified into a Severe cyclonic storm at 0530 hours IST of today, the 10th October 2018, moved North-wards and lay cantered at 0830 hours IST, over same area near Lat.16.5°N and Long. 85.8°E, about 320 km South-southeast of Gopalpur (Odisha) and 270 km southeast of Kalingapatnam (Andhra Pradesh). It is very likely to intensify further into a Very Severe Cyclonic Storm during next 3 hours. It is very likely to move North-Northwest-wards and cross Odisha & adjoining north Andhra Pradesh coasts between Gopalpur & Kalingapatnam around morning of 11th October. Thereafter, it is very likely to re-curve northeastwards, move towards Gangetic West Bengal across Odisha and weaken gradually.

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
