**Maximum Temperature over Tamil Nadu and Puducherry:**

**Summary & Forecast**

**I. Summary of Observations recorded at 1730 IST of 24.05.2018**

1. Under the influence of thunderstorm activity and fairly widespread rainfall over Tamilnadu, maximum temperature over most parts of plains of Tamil Nadu and Puducherry was around 33-37°C except over some pockets of extreme northeastern parts where it was about 38-40°C.
2. Tiruttani recorded the highest maximum temperature of 40°C.

**II. Forecast**

Maximum temperature over some parts of Thiruvallur, Kanchipuram, Vellore, Thiruvannamalai, Karur, Tiruchi and Perambalur districts is likely to be around 38-40°C during the next 24 hrs.

**III. Local forecast for Chennai City and neighbourhood**

Maximum temperature over Chennai and neighbourhood is likely to be around 36-38°C during the next 24 hours.
